Applying for Membership

Membership is open to organisations, whether they be sole traders, partnerships or companies, who are actively engaged in operating private crematoria and cemeteries.

Membership is not open therefore to crematoria and cemeteries operated by and under the control of local authorities.

An application form will then be provided which includes an undertaking to conform to the constitution and rules of the APCC, if the applicant is accepted for membership. The application will be presented at the next meeting of the association and will be accepted provided three-fourths majority vote in favour.

Each organisation elected to membership will be treated as an individual member and may be represented by any director, officer or nominated representative. Each member has one vote.

Entrance Fees and Subscription

The entrance fee for new members is reviewed annually and currently ranges from £65.00 – £425 per site.

Meetings

The Association meets formally at least three times per year, one of which is an annual general meeting.

Sub-committees and working groups are formed as necessary to tackle particular subjects.
